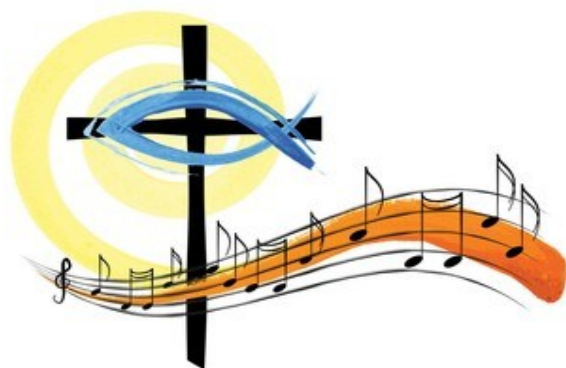

Hydration During Extreme Heat – Important Update



When indoor temperatures reach 26°C or higher, we work with all departments to ensure residents stay hydrated throughout the day.

- Extra fluids are offered starting in the morning and throughout the day.
- Residents are at higher risk of dehydration due to factors like reduced thirst, medications, incontinence concerns, and swallowing difficulties.
- Water is often served with juice, iced tea, lemonade, tea, or coffee to increase intake.
- Fluids are best accepted in small, frequent servings with regular encouragement.
- Recreation and physio teams help distribute drinks on weekdays; care staff support hydration during meals.
- Activity programs will be adjusted during extreme heat to reduce exertion.
